Caryl Bryer Fallert Biography

Caryl Bryer Fallert is internationally recognized for her luminous, award-winning art quilts. Her work has appeared in hundreds of national and international publications, and can be found in museum, corporate, public, and private collections in 22 states and six foreign countries. Honors include: 100 Most Important Quilts of the Twentieth Century (2000), 30 Most Influential Quilters in the World (2002), Bernina of America Quilt Leadership Award (2003), AQS All American Quilter (2004), and International Quilt Festival Silver Star (lifetime achievement) Award (2006). Fallert's quilts have won best of show at the International Quilt Festival (2009), American Quilters Society Show (1989, 1995 and 2000) and more than a dozen other national and international exhibitions. Fallert has authored two books and numerous workshops on CD-ROM. She finds her greatest joy designing and making her quilts and sharing what she has learned with students in her workshops and lectures, which have taken her to 11 countries on five continents. Her goal as a workshop leader is to help each student find the key to her/his personal creative style. In April of 2006, she opened the Bryerpatch Studio shop, gallery and workshop center in Paducah, Kentucky's historic Lower Town Arts District.
